Sewing Project:	Fabric and supplies to buy:	Due dates:
Drawstring Bag Cost: \$1	8" by 18" thick woven fabric 20" drawstring or ribbon	October 3
Pillowcase Cost: \$5	Main Fabric— 3/4 yard Matching Fabric— 1/3 yard	October 3
Stuff Bag Cost: \$1	12" by 12" thick woven fabric 12" zipper	October 3
Tote bag with zipper Cost: \$5	7/8 yards thick woven fabric 3 ¼ yard of 1" webbing/strapping 20 inch zipper , thread	October 15
Stuffed animal Cost: \$1	12" by 12" woven fabric small bag of stuffing	October 15
Memory Quilt OR 9-patch pillow Choose 1.  Cost: \$1	<u>Both:</u> old jeans, leftover fabric embellishments (optional)— decorative buttons, iron-ons, patches, lace, ribbon, etc. <u>Quilt:</u> batting and fabric to cover back—1 ¼ yard each. <u>Pillow:</u> ½ yard woven fabric and 1 small pillow form (12") (or small bag of stuffing).	November 1
Pajama Shorts Cost: \$6	1 ½ yards woven fabric, thread, ½ inch elastic that fits the waist, elastic shorts pattern	November 23
Total: \$20		

You can choose to pay the teacher for the project or bring your own fabric and supplies. Money can be paid after October 1<sup>st</sup> online or in the office. Bring in the receipt.

Fee Waiver students only need to bring the fabric for each of the projects.

(3 yards of fabric will be enough for all of the projects).

Bring money or supplies by the due dates or sooner so that students will have time to finish projects before the end of the semester.
