NEW STUDENTS

(Came from school within Granite School District)

Use the password you had at your last school.

STUDENTS THAT FORGOT THEIR PASSWORD OR THEIR PASSWORD IS NOT WORKING.

- Try to logon to another machine.
- If you still cannot get in, have your teacher reset your password.

After signing in with the new password your teacher gives you and you're on the desktop, hit CTRL + ALT + DEL. Click on the Change Password button, enter the old password (the one the teacher gave you) then enter a password in the next two boxes that you'll remember. It must follow the password rules.

You can also use this information if you need to change your password for some reason.

It must be at least 7 characters.

Use 3 of these 4 rules:

- At least 1 UPPER CASE letter
- At least 1 lower case letter
- At least 1 number
- At least 1 symbol (&#@\$)

-You may NOT use:

- Any part of your name
- Your student number
